

Local Rules
(USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by local rules)

1. Keep carts at least 30 feet from greens and tees, or on cart paths.
2. Repair all divots and ball marks. Rake all traps and leave the rakes in the traps.
3. Groups should play within the recommended pace of play time of 4 hours. Please allow faster groups to play through when there is an opening ahead of you.
4. Out of Bounds defined by white stakes and boundary fencing (holes #4 through #8).
5. Yardage is measured to the center of greens. The color of the flag denotes relative position of the flag on the green. Red = Front. White = Middle. Checkered = Back
6. A mandatory drop is required from all tree wells and planted areas. Proceed under Rule 24-2.
7. A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest on another part of the golf course beyond that boundary is out of bounds.
8. Stones in bunkers are treated as movable obstructions under rule 24-1 and can be removed from the bunker.
9. The Kikuyu grass control groove around greens: if a player's ball comes to rest in the groove, the player may, without penalty, lift and place backwards or sideways, no closer to the hole.
10. You are prohibited from bringing your own alcohol on to the premises.
